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Preceptorship Form

This application is to be submitted to the PEIVMA council for any preceptorship taking place on Prince Edward Island, as described under the Veterinary Act, sections 19-20. If any senior veterinary student is completing external rotations on PEI, or working at a clinic before being fully licensed, a preceptorship form must be submitted. **A preceptor is a licensed member of the PEIVMA** who agrees to supervise a student to further his/her training. Once the preceptorship is registered, **the member's license covers all veterinary work done by the preceptee**. Senior veterinary students during their final year of studies, or after their studies are completed but before they are eligible for licensure on PEI can be preceptees. Other veterinary candidates preparing to take examinations under the National Examination Board may also act as preceptees. More information can be found in the Veterinary Act, peivma.com, or by contacting the PEIVMA.

All applications should be submitted to the PEIVMA, see below, a minimum of 2 weeks before the start date of the preceptorship. Once approved, a preceptorship is effective for a period of six months. The PEIVMA council may authorize, if requested in writing, up to two additional six month periods per student, to take place with the same, or different, preceptors. **The end date will be six months from approval OR when the preceptee is eligible to be licensed (usually date of graduation).**
