Equine Internship/Veterinary Assistantship/Auxiliary – (2017 -2018) Milton Equine Hospital – Milton ON, CANADA

Milton Equine Hospital is located in the Greater Toronto Area near Milton, Ontario. We are a 24/7 surgical referral hospital.

Milton Equine Hospital offers six (6) paid internships annually from June 30 to July 1. Our aim is to provide post-graduate teaching and training that will prepare the intern for a residency program, or private practice, through the combination of a high caseload and informal daily interaction with the surgeons.

We hope to be able to assist each intern by advancing their diagnostic, clinical and therapeutic decision-making skills. Our interns rotate through different services, including surgery, out-patient, anesthesia and emergency services every six weeks to ensure that they experience a broad range of disciplines. The philosophy at MEH is to provide the highest quality of patient care and the best service to our clients and our interns play a crucial role in achieving that aim.

We welcome graduate veterinarians as interns from Canada and around the world. Completion of this internship/assistantship should fulfill the requirements necessary to pursue one of several residency programs or allow the candidate to enter a high-caliber private practice.

Remuneration for this internship position is \$27,700 CDN. Accommodations are available onsite.

Job Requirements:

The year-long position requires a Doctorate in Veterinary Medicine (DVM) or an equivalent degree (MV, MVB, LV, DMV, VMD, etc.). A knowledge base of horses is required as well as an avid interest in fields inter-connected with equine surgery, radiology, anesthesiology, reproduction and internal medicine.
